Dear Mr. Vaigneur:

I have discovered since talking to you yesterday that the opinion relating to Greenwood County which I had mentioned to you does not have any real relevance to your position as Jaspe County Supervisor for the unexpired remainder of your term. Nevertheless, my opinion is that, since Jasper County has selecte the council-administrator form of county government and is operating pursuant thereto and since the administrator performs the functions of a supervisor under that form, your duties as a hold-over supervisor most probably can consist only of those assigned to you by the council which do not derogate from those granted to the administrator by the provisions of Act No. 283 of 1975, the 'home rule' legislation.
