In response to your letter of January 2, 1975, enclosed please find a copy of Section 4-203.4, South Carolina Code of Laws (1962), as amended, which allows minors under the age of eighteen (18) years to sell or deliver beer in unopened containers while in the lawful course of their employment. As long as the containers are sold and/or delivered in an unopened condition, the provisions of the law are met.
