Dear Tom:

Thank you for your letter of January 20, 1975, asking what constitutes the Florence County Legislative Delegation within the meaning of the Act creating the Florence County Fire District, which provides:

‘There is established a board of fire control for the district to be composed of twelve members who shall be appointed by the Governor, two from each subdistrict, upon the recommendation of a majority of the Florence County Legislative Delegation.’

It is my opinion that two Senators and a majority of the Members of the House constitute a majority.

In my opinion, Section 30-203.1 of the Code of Laws, 1962, controls in this case and by its provisions two Senators and a majority of the Members of the House constitute the Florence County Legislative Delegation. A majority of the Members of the House consists of at least three Members.
