Dear Congressman:

You have inquired as to whether a State employee may accept part-time work with your office to serve as a clerk during times which do not conflict with her employment with a State agency.

I advise that there is no prohibition against this procedure insofar as State law is concerned.

The agency involved is primarily federal-funded and I am advised by the appropriate personnel officer of that agency that there are no federal regulations or restrictions imposed which would prohibit such employment by you.
