Dear Mr. Jones:

In answer to your letter concerning payment of medical bills of a high school student injured in a shop class, there are no State funds designated for purposes of this type. Under art. 10, § 3 of the South Carolina Constitution, revenues levied for one purpose cannot be applied to another; therefore, funds cannot be transferred from other purposes for such medical expenses.
