Dear Mr. Bishop:

You have requested an opinion from this Office as to whether an Arcade may be open for business on Sundays. Assuming that an Arcade is an establishment for the operation of pinball machines and pool tables, the opinion of this Office is that it is unlawful for a person to engage in the business of operating these machines or games on Sundays. This opinion is predicated on the authority of Section 64-1, 1962 Code of Laws of South Carolina (generally referred to as the Sunday Blue Law).
