Dear Mr. Leventis:

There are at the present time no State statutes which would resolve the problem regarding the equalization of taxation in a school district that overlaps county lines. As you will note from the attached memorandum and will recall from our prior conversation, the resolution of this inequity should be attempted by an action for declaratory judgment.

As you will note from the enclosed memorandum, it is our conclusion that a county in which a school board has all of its school buildings can not require that the portion of the school district not located within that county join another district.
