Dear Mr. Board:

You have inquired whether or not it is a violation of State law for a person who has been convicted of a crime of violence to possess a rifle or shotgun.

This Office has not been able to locate a State statute prohibiting such possession. As you have noted, possession of pistols by such persons is prohibited. (Sec. 16–129.2, 1962 Code of Laws of South Carolina, as amended). Yours very truly,
