Dear Mayor Blackwood:

Attached hereto is a copy of Section 5-103 of the 1962 Code of Laws of South Carolina, as amended. As you can see, this Section permits athletic events on Sunday under certain circumstances.

If your city and/or county fits into one of the categories set out therein, such events are proper.

Special attention should be given to Subsections (3) and (4) which set out the Permit requirements and the penalties for violation of this Section.

It appears from the 1970 census figures, that neither Union nor Union County fit under the various population categories set up by this section. As a result, under this statute, Sunday Baseball games are unlawful. Sincerely yours,
