You have asked for an opinion of this Office regarding the formation of an auxiliary police force for your municipality.

This Office has expressed the opinion several times that there is no authority whatsoever for the creation of an auxiliary police force by a municipality, absent such authorization by legislative enactment. My research has revealed no act authorizing the creation of an auxiliary police force by the City of Union.
