Dear Senator Long:

You have inquired as to the validity of an act that would permit a single municipality to create and maintain a so-called auxiliary police force.

Article 8, Constitution of South Carolina, as amended, reads in part: 'Section 10. No laws for a specific municipality shall be enacted, - - -.'

In view of the quoted Constitutional provision, it is the opinion of this Office that an act permitting a specific municipality to create and maintain an auxiliary police force would be invalid.
