Dear Ms. Goff:

This letter is in reference to our telephone conversation of this morning in which you inquired if a person could hold the position of mayor and State constable. The position of mayor is an office within the constitutional prohibition which provides that no person shall hold two offices of honor or profit at the same time. It has been the prior opinion of this office that the position of State constable would also be an office. See 1973 Attorney General Opinions, p. 28 which is enclosed. Therefore, one person could not hold the position of mayor and State constable.
