Dear Dean McCullough:

With reference to your letter concerning the effect on accrued annual leave when a faculty member changes from a 12-month contract to a 9-month contract; I have been in contact with both the State personnel office and the University personnel office. It seems that faculty members do not come under the State's annual leave act and thus they are governed by University policy. The University policy as set forth in the faculty manual is that when one changes from a 12-month contract to a 9-month contract, he must either use his accrued annual leave or lose it. He will not be reimbursed for it.
