Dear Captain Fennell:

You have inquired as to the meaning of the word 'minor' as used in Section 46-159, 1962 Code of Laws of South Carolina.

On February 6, 1975, the General Assembly ratified an amendment to the Constitution of South Carolina making persons eighteen years of age <u>sui juris</u>. Under provisions of such amendment the age of majority in this State is now eighteen years.
