Dear Dr. Beckman:

This is to certify that the South Carolina Vocational Rehabilitation Department was created and established by Act No. 108 of the 1957 Acts [1957 (50) 114], commonly referred to as "The Vocational Rehabilitation Act of South Carolina". Act No. 108 is codified in Chapter 6, Title 71, Section 71-271, et seq., Code of Laws of South Carolina (1962) as amended. These provisions are the legal authority for the South Carolina Vocational Rehabilitation Department being denominated the State agency to receive and administer Federal funds for the purpose of vocational rehabilitation services in South Carolina, with the exception of the program of vocational rehabilitation of the blind which is administered by the South Carolina Commission for the Blind [Chapter 6.1, Title 71, Section 71-291, et seq., Code of Laws of South Carolina (1962), as amended].
