Dear Mr. Rampey:

Thank you for your letter of April 10, 1975, concerning the position of institutional officer with the Greenville Technical College and the elective position of a Member of the General Assembly.

In order to appraise the situation precisely, it will be necessary to know the exact position involved. Is it created by statute or is it a position created by administrative procedures of the College? The answers to these questions will determine the view which I take upon the matter.

With respect to other employees, such as instructors or employees who are subject to the State Classification and Compensation Act, it is probable that these would normally be considered employees and not officers as the latter term is used in the constitutional sense. It is necessary to consider each position in order to reach a determination.

With this information, I think we will be in a position to respond to your questions.
