**\*1 In Re: Mandatory Closing Hours for Non-Regulated Pool Tables**

Dear Chief Copeland:

You have inquired as to the mandatory opening and closing hours 'for a pool room' with non-regulated tables'. You asked also about regulations regarding Sunday openings and closings.

Unless a place of business is a pool room within the definition of the pool room statute, the mandatory closing hours for pool rooms do not apply. As for Sunday operation, the requirements of the pool room statutes do not apply, but the question of prohibited Sunday work under Section 64-1, 1962 Code of Laws of South Carolina, might come into effect.
