The game of Bingo, if a charge is made for playing and a prize given for winning, is a lottery under the Constitution and laws of the State of South Carolina, and is prohibited unless it is conducted by a recognized State or County Fair or a charitable, religious or fraternal organization exempt from Federal taxation.
