Dear Sgt. Hamilton:

There is no State law which prohibits the appointment of one under the age of twenty-one years as a city policeman, provided he is a registered elector and has the legal capacity to execute a bond, if such is required. However, primarily because the city or department may impose additional qualifications upon applicants for such positions I suggest that you direct your inquiry to your city attorney.
