Dear Mr. Cobb:

Mr. Coleman has referred your recent letter to me for reply. You have inquired if South Carolina Code of Laws, 1962, Sections 4-102 and 23-658 which prohibit the sale and transfer of alcoholic liquors on election day would extend their prohibition to lounges and taverns. A prior opinion of this office, which I am enclosing, held that the prohibition against the sale of alcoholic liquors on election days does not apply to the sale of minibottles. Therefore, a lounger or tavern could sell minibottles on election day.
