Dear Mr. Jennings:

We are in receipt of your recent letter in which you raised various questions concerning Act No. 418 of the 1973 Acts and Joint Resolutions. Specifically, you have inquired which district is referred to in Section 2, subsection 2 of the Act. This Section reads as follows:

Four persons shall be appointed by the Commissioners of the North Charleston Sewer District Commission from the qualified electors residing in the district for a term of two years from the date of their appointment and until their successors are appointed and qualify.

Section 1 of this Act states:

There is hereby created the Cooper River Park and Playground Commission whose territorial jurisdiction shall extend over all that area in Charleston County north of the City of Charleston designated as the 'North Charleston District' pursuant to Act No. 1768 of 1972...

The 1972 Act refers back to the original act of 1957, Act No. 521, which states at Section 1

... the District shall include and be comprised of so much of that portion of Charleston County lying generally to the north of the boundaries of the City of Charleston as is set forth and delineated on a map or plat thereof made by the John McCrady Co., dated April, 1957, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Charleston County on the 30th day of April, 1957, in Plat Book 'L', page 23.

It would be my opinion that this above-cited definition constitutes the 'district' referred to in Act No. 418 of the 1973 Acts. Any person living within this area, which I believe is generally known as North Charleston, could be appointed to the Cooper River Park and Playground Commission.
