Dear Ms. Padgett:

Your request for information on rules and procedural matters dealing with Town Councils has been forwarded to me for reply.

The 'Home Rule Bill' S-18, R396, has provisions that may prove relevant to your inquiry. Article 3, Sections 47-49 and 47-50 deal with forfeiture of office of Mayor and Councilman. (Copies Enclosed)

Generally, forfeiture of office has been necessitated only by <u>gross</u> neglect, inefficiency, incapacity or immorality. Censure is the recourse most often taken in violation of the nature you've mentioned.

It appears that while a town council may set up its own rules regarding attendance that in-body expulsion is not within the members' power.
