Dear Senator Harris:

In reply to your inquiry, I advise that the Board of Commissioners for Chesterfield County has the authority to set a referendum to permit the voters to choose the form of government they wish and to choose the form of representation they desire.

There is no reason why a legislative delegation or any member thereof may not work cooperatively with the governing body and make such suggestions. This procedure was followed recently in Lexington County and the County Council, in that instance, has ordered a referendum to be held on a specified date.
