## Dear Tom:

Thank you for your letter of December 17, 1975, inquiring if the action of a mayor in redrawing the city limits, as shown on the county assessor's map, so as (apparently) to remove an exterior from inclusion within the city limits, would be violative of the provisions of Section 47-205, Code of Laws, 1962.

Based upon the mere statements in your letter, I do not think that a violation is indicated. If additional facts and circumstances are made available, it is entirely possible that a violation may be indicated, in which case I would suggest that the entire matter be submitted to the solicitor of the proper judicial circuit for consideration by him.
