Dear Mr. Lane:

This office has been advised that you have stated that you will not pay your soybean assessment payment as required under the provisions of Marketing Act No. 1 for South Carolina Soybeans.

I refer you to the provisions of Section 3-235.39 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1971 Cu, Supp., which provide a maximum penalty of a \$500.00 fine and imprisonment for six months for violation of the foregoing marketing order. If you do not pay the assessment due by you, within ten days of the date of this letter, or make satisfactory arrangements for the payment thereof, this office will have no alternative but institute appropriate legal proceedings to enforce a payment which is due.
