Dear Mr. Flythe:

This office has been requested to respond to your letter in which you requested refund for general contractors licensing for the year 1972 and 1973. I regret to advise you that there is no statutory authorization for the refund of any fees paid in conjunction with obtaining a license from the State Licensing Board for Contractors. License fees so obtained are deposited with the general fund of the State, and accordingly become State monies. The only method by which you might pursue your claim would be to file a claim against the State of South Carolina for the return of any monies you feel are owed to you by the State.
