This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter date May 7, 1974. In that letter you request opinion concerning good conduct credit to be awarded Horry County prisoners. after looking into the matter I, find where this office issued an opinion dated November 5, 1974, concerning the identical question. This in Opinion No. 3407 found on 1971-72 Ops. Atty. Gen. page 278. The only change in the law since that time is to the effect that consecutive sentences may new be aggregated for the purpose of computing good behavior credit. The legislation was enacted changing the law in this area. I hope this answers your questions. If these is anything further, please let me know.
