Dear Mr. Jordan:

I regret that I have been precluded until now from responding to your letter of April 26.

You inquire if Mr. David L. Eagerton is authorized to serve as a member of the Board of Trustees of Florence School District No. 1 while at the same time serving as an employee of the South Carolina Rehabilitation Department.

Mr. Eagerton is employed in the capacity of counselor with the Vocational Rehabilitation Department. This position, in my opinion, is not an office, but is an employment, and Mr. Eagerton is not therefore prohibited from occupying an office of trust, honor or profit at the same time. It is my opinion that the service in this dual capacity is not violative of the dual officeholding provision of the State Constitution.
