Attorney General McLeod read with interest your letter of July 9, 1974 and referred it to me for consideration and reply. You have expressed concern as to whether South Carolina's Narcotics and Controlled Substances Act, Act No. 445 of 1971, covers various types and kinds of substances related generically to marihuana.

The Act was amended during the recent session of the General Assembly as so to close what was seen, as you suggest, as a possible loophole in the law. Enclosed you will find a copy of the amended version of House Bill 2910, which passed both Houses of the Legislative. The legislation has not yet been printed as an Act but will be designated R. 1448.
