Thank you for your letter of June 21, which has been referred to me for reply. Magisterial districts are arranged as prescribed by law. In this case the applicable statute is Section 43-1011 of the 1962 South Carolina Code of Laws, as amended, which pertains specifically to Spartanburg County.

Jurisdictions of Magistrate's Courts in criminal actions is limited to offenses occurring within that particular Magistrate's district under Act No. 801 of the General Assembly of South Carolina of 1966. Note that all the questions you have raised are answered by this Act.
