Dear Mr. Rudnick:

Attorney General McLeod referred to me your letter requesting information concerning the residency requirement found in the Reapportionment Act. Unfortunately, I have not been able to reply until now because of the priority given to cases in litigation and requests from agencies and political subdivisions; but, your question is still timely since you are concerned about your qualifications if you won the primary or if you intend to wage a write-in candidacy should you have lost the primary. In answer to your question, in my opinion, Article 3, Section 7 of the Constitution of South Carolina does not limit the qualifications for the House of Representatives to those found in this particular section alone.
