Thank you for your letter of August 15, 1974, in which you inquired whether an individual can serve as a member of District No. 20 Constituent School Board and as a member of the Charleston County Housing and Redevelopment Authority.

Each of these positions is created by the General Assembly and exercises a portion of the sovereignty of the state. It is the opinion of this office that each of these positions constitutes an office within the meaning of the dual office holding prohibition of the Constitution of this State and that the same individual may not therefore hold both offices at the same time.
