Dear Chief Green:

You have requested that we advise you as to whether or not a police officer may arrest a person who, in view of the officer, commits a misdemeanor on private property.

In South Carolina, a police officer may arrest any person who commits a misdemeanor in the officer's view. CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA § 17-253 (1962). Whether the offense occurs on private property is immaterial. <u>Cf.</u>, 5 AM.JUR.2d <u>Arrest</u> § 86 at 774.
