Dear Mr. Moncrief:

I have been asked to review the Commission's Policy and Procedure Manual of the Business Enterprise Program. Accordingly, I submit the following comments:

- 1. <u>S. C. Code</u> § 1-33 and <u>S. C. Code</u> §§ 71-291 through 300 all pertain to the Commission's responsibilities to visually handicapped persons and could properly be included with the other legal authorities attached to the manual.
- 2. Portions of the body fo the manual duplicate material contained in the attachments to the manual e.g., the sections on manager responsibilities and on fair hearings. I recommend that these sections incorporate by reference the language in the pertinent attachments, rather than restate the language, in order to prevent possible confusion should a future change to an attachment inadvertently not also be incorporated into the body of the manual.
- 3. The fair hearing procedure has been slightly reworked (draft enclosed) in order to conform more closely to S. C. Code § 71-299, and to provide more specific instructions for filing both requests for hearings and for appeals. Additionally, I have deleted the 30 day time limit on the filing of a request for a fair hearing as I believe that S. C. Code § 10-143 entitles an aggrieved party to six (6) years within which to pursue his right to a hearing. I also would recommend that the Commission determine whether or not on an appeal from a fair hearing it wishes the hearing officer or itself to be the final authority on questions of fact, and to so provide.
- 4. Finally, I respectfully suggest that the mannual be closely read for style, syntax and phraseology, as previously discussed on August 28, 1974.
