In confirmation of our telephone conversation of October 3, 1974, and your letter of October 3, 1974, this is to affirm my oral opinion that the low bid submitted by Cobb and Sabbagha of Columbia does not conform to the Invitation to Bid for the Informary project. Specifically, the Invitation to Bid on Project No. 10-13, the Infirmary for the School for the Deaf and the Blind, contains a statement that all bids must be accompanied by a Bid Bond. The Cobb and Sabbagha Bid was not accompanied by a Bid Bond and does not meet the requirements of the Invitation to Bid at the time the Bids were opened. Therefore, Cobb and Sabbagha's Bid must be rejected.
