**CONSENT ORDER AS TO
DEFENDANT GARY BOHLKE**

This matter comes before this Court pursuant to a motion to accept a Consent Order (the "Order") as to the remaining Defendant named above, Gary S. Bohlke ("Bohlke" or "the Settling Defendant"), proposed by counsel for Bohlke and designed to resolve this matter as to Bohlke. After consideration of this motion, the Plaintiff's lack of objection to the motion, and the pleadings filed in connection with this action, I hereby find and conclude as follows:

1. This Court has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter of this action, and venue is proper in Richland County;
2. Without admitting or denying the allegations of the Plaintiff, except as to this Court's jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter of these proceedings, which are admitted, the Settling Defendant consents to the entry of this Order and agrees to the terms set forth below;
3. The terms set forth below are acceptable to the Plaintiff, who also consents to entry of this Order; and

4. Based upon the foregoing and the laws of the State of South Carolina, sufficient grounds exist to order the relief set forth in this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, DECREED, and ADJUDGED THAT:

- a. The Settling Defendant is hereby enjoined from future violations of the South Carolina Uniform Securities Act of 2005; and
- b. The Settling Defendant is permanently barred from participating in any aspect of the securities industry in or from the State of South Carolina beginning on the date of execution of this Order; and
- c. Within sixty (60) days of the Court's entry of this Order, Defendant Gary S. Bohlke shall pay a fine in the amount of seven thousand, five hundred dollars (\$7,500.00) to the Plaintiff.

Upon execution by counsel for the Plaintiff, counsel for the Settling Defendant, and this Court, this Order finally resolves the Plaintiff's case against the Settling Defendant. The Plaintiff's case against all other Defendants is unchanged by this Order.
