Dear Mr. Tisdale:

Thank you for your letter of November 22, 1974, in which you requested information concerning the procedure for alteration of city limits. The South Carolina Code of Laws provides procedures to be followed for annexation of additional property. In general there are two main forms of annexation, by election or petition. See South Carolina Code of Laws, 1962, Section 47-11; South Carolina Code of Laws, 1962, as amended, Sections 47-19.5, 47-19.11. I would advise you to contact your city or county attorney concerning the situation you have presented in your letter and he should be able to inform you what procedure was utilized.
