Dear Mr. Blease:

You have inquired as to whether the full-slate law will require every voter to vote for nine candidates in the school board election to be held on December 17 next.

A similar request was made to this office and the answer to the question is set forth below.

You have inquired as to whether or not the so-called full slate law as to elections [Sec. 4(2), Act No. 971, Acts of 1966] is still in effect.

The full slate law was deleted from the election laws of this State by Act No. 1204 of 1972. It is no longer necessary that a voter cast his ballot for the full number of persons to be elected to an office.
