Dear Mr. Snipes:

The following inquiry has been submitted by Mr. Gerald Clay on your behalf:

‘Abbeville County recently received a draft from the Revenue Sharing Plan, same being paid directly to the Supervisor of Abbeville County. These funds have been withheld by the Supervisor and are not being run through the office of the County Treasurer. Mr. Snipes is requesting information as to whether or not it is incumbent upon the Supervisor to place said funds with the County Treasurer for disbursement thereafter.’

In reply thereto, I advise that I find no authority for the retention of funds by any officer in Abbeville County except the Treasurer and, in my opinion, the funds received under the Revenue Sharing Act should be transmitted to the Treasurer of Abbeville County for disposition as the governing body may provide.
