## Gentlemen:

You have inquired as to the necessity of a search warrant to make lawful the search of a building operated unlawfully as an unlicensed business.

If it is necessary for you to gain entrance to such premises forcibly, a search warrant will be necessary in almost every instance—particularly if you anticipate having to search the premises. The affidavit to support the warrant should contain enough <u>factual</u> information to support your belief that an unlawful business is being operated.
