In answer to your request for an opinion relating to the imminent municipal election in Lancaster, the Courts have struck down and the General Assembly has repealed the full slate law, a notary public may administer the oath of office, and the fact that no one offers for a particular office in no way effects the validity of the election insofar as any other offices are concerned.
