Before your appointment as County Attorney, you conferred with this Office to inquire if this appointment would be in conflict with your position as State Senator. At that time, I informed you that it was my opinion that you would not be violating the dual officeholding provision of the Constitution by assuming the position of County Attorney also.

This is to reaffirm to you that it is the opinion of this Office that the holding of the position of County Attorney for Williamsburg County and the position of State Senator does not violate the dual officeholding provisions of our law.
