Dear Mr. Wheless:

This is in reference to your inquiry concerning walkways over Ocean Boulevard. Similar walkways over State highways have been constructed in South Carolina, the one over Blossom Street to the University in Columbia being one example.

It is our opinion that the Town of North Myrtle Beach and the State Highway Department would have to consent to the walkways, and that an easement should be obtained for such. As to any specific requirements that such a walkway would have to meet, plans and specifications for a walkway should be submitted to both the Town and the Department for their approval. Sections 33-171 and 33-173 in the Supplement to the Code may be of some assistance to you.
