Dear General McCrady:

I advise that, in my opinion, funds derived from a sale of obsolete armories under the procedure set forth in § 44-105, Code of Laws, 1962, may be used to rehabilitate and rebuild certain buildings at the South Carolina National Guard's weekend training site at Leesburg for the purpose of using such buildings as a part of the school program armory complex. Such expenditures, in my opinion, may be made from the construction of armories account funds for the purposes indicated.
