Dear Mr. Marshall: Your letter of August 9, 1973, addressed to the Attorney General has been handed to me for attention and reply.

You have requested a copy of the latest Act concerning penalties relating to the dumping of trash on certain property, highways or waters.

The most recant amendment to South Carolina Code § 16-396 was approved on April 27, 1973. It increases the maximum penalty from one hundred to two hundred dollars; provides for the jurisdiction of magistrates; and deletes a duplication of penalty in the old act. You will find enclosed a copy of this amendment.
