Dear Ed:

Thank you for your letter of August 20 inquiring if it would be a conflict of interest if you sold the Animal Husbandry Department at Clemson University Quantities of Milo.

As you have no affiliation with the University, I can see no conflict of interest which would arise should you undertake to make such sale. Your position as State Senator does not, in my opinion, affect your right to sell at all. The persons who would be prohibited from dealing with Clenson are those persons who are members of its Board of Trustees or other persons in authority at the University. This, in my opinion, does not include you as State Senator.
