Dear Mr. Collins:

You have asked whether the above named authority is an employer within the meaning of South Carolina Code of Laws, Section 61-1(5). The Greenville County Commission on Alcohol and Drug Abuse Control was created by Act No. 421, 1971 Acts and Joints Resolutions. The Statute provides definite terms for the members of the Commission, who are to be appointed by the Governor. In Section 3 of said Act, it clearly provides that the Commission shall be a body politic.

Based on the foregoing, it is the opinion of this Office that the Greenville County Commission on Alcohol and Drug Abuse Control is a political subdivision of the State and an employer within the meaning of Code Section 61-1(5).
