As I stated, I think the answer to your question as to whether or not the Airport Commission is immune from suit is found in McKenzie v. City of Florence, 234 S.C. 428, 108 S.E.2d 825, and many other cases.

I am enclosing herewith a letter which I wrote to Jack Nettles, in which I expressed the view that a portion of the Airport statute (Section 2-311.2) has no constitutional infirmity in my opinion.
