I regret that I have not answered your letter of October 10 which I discussed with you this morning on the telephone.

As I stated, I think the answer to your question as to whether or not the Airport Commission is immune from suit is found in [McKenzie v. City of Florence](#), 234 S.C. 428, 108 S.E.2d 825, and many other cases.

I am enclosing herewith a letter which I wrote to Jack Nettles, in which I expressed the view that a portion of the Airport statute (Section 2-311.2) has no constitutional infirmity in my opinion.
