Dear Mr. Boozer:

You have requested that we advise you as to whether or not full time faculty and administrative employees of South Carolina's technical education centers and their spouses and children fall within the exception to the operation of Section 22-2.2 of the South Carolina Code of Laws, as amended, that is created by Section 22-2.2(D) thereof. Subsection (D) of Section 22-2.2 reads: Full time faculty and administrative employees of State institutions, and the husbands, wives or children of such employees, shall be excluded from the operation of this section.

Inasmuch as the technical education centers of this State constitute, in our judgment, State institutions of higher learning [see, e.g., 52 STAT. Act No. 323(3) at 543 (1961)] such employees, their spouses and children are exempted by Subsection (D) from the operations of Section 22-2.3 of the Code.
